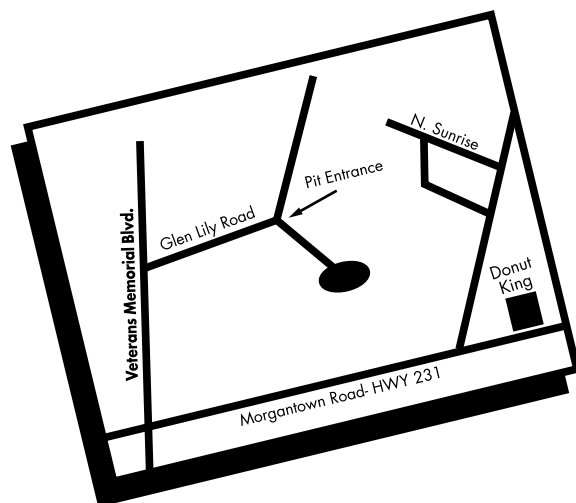

RULES FOR COMPACT CAR FIGURE 8 RACE

1. 106" wheel base maximum — no 8 cylinders.
2. Each driver must have a valid driver's license and must be a minimum of 18 years of age, or have a notarized release signed by a parent or guardian. NO PROFESSIONAL DRIVERS are allowed.
3. Any car posing a question of safety will be rejected from competition.
4. **The track officials reserve the right to approve or reject any and all entries.**
5. Each driver must sign a release form at the time of the car's registration and inspection. Only those who have signed a release will be permitted on the track.
6. The Southern Kentucky Fair Board will not be responsible for any cars, trucks or personal property before, during or after the show.
7. Any car violation discovered during or after competition will result in disqualification and forfeiture of all prizes.
8. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds following the show or they will become property of the Southern Kentucky Fair Board.
9. The decision of the judges will be final—**NO EXCEPTIONS!**
10. Any driver or anyone speaking for the driver using foul language in ring, announcer's table or crowd area will cause that driver to be disqualified and forfeit any prize money.
11. **The use of illegal drugs or intoxicating beverages prior to, or during the derby, disqualifies the car and the crew of the offending party.**
12. All participants must be on grounds by 6:00 p.m. All drivers must attend a driver's meeting.
13. No trucks allowed.
14. Safety belt and approved safety helmets are required.
15. All glass with the exception of the windshield (including side windows, headlights, taillights, mirrors, etc.) MUST be removed. Rolling windows down is not permitted.
16. No special bumper, trailer hitches or reinforcements will be allowed.
17. All doors must be fastened shut by #9 wire or 5/16" chain (4 points per door) or welded.
18. All chrome stripping and protruding objects must be removed.
19. No sand or concrete in doors or panels, no water in tanks or tires, or any other extra weight devices will be permitted.
20. No spring jacks or blocked shocks.
21. Hood and deck lids must be operational for inspection. Can wire shut.
22. All vehicles must have operational brake systems. Vehicles must have brakes before beginning competition.
23. Tire size shall not exceed 1000-15. **No double tires.**
24. The number of heats will be determined the night of the derby.
25. One 4" bar allowed on driver's door inside car, minimum.
26. One 4" bar allowed behind driver's seat, not to extend past center floorboard.
27. Only engines matching car manufacturer allowed—Ford/Ford; GM/GM, etc.

COMPETITION:

1. 4 Heats maximum — Minimum 4 cars per Heat.
2. 1st and 2nd Place each Heat - \$50 Prize.
3. 10 Lap Heats — 15 Lap Feature.
4. Feature Race:
 - 1st Place in Heats — Line Up First
 - 2nd Place in Heats — Line Up Second
 - Other Cars — Line Up Third
5. Blind draw for positioning in each of 3 groups.
6. Blind draw for line up in individual heats.
7. Any car catching fire is disqualified.
8. Driver must stay in car unless told to do otherwise by official.
9. In the event car leaves track area, they are disqualified.

ANY ANNOUNCEMENTS MADE TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER PRINTED MATERIAL.

THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES AND DERBY OFFICIALS WILL BE FINAL.
