1. All animals must be on the grounds by 9:00 a.m. (Central Daylight Savings Time)
2. Proof of registration must accompany all animals.
3. Show to begin at 10:00 a.m. (Central Daylight Savings Time)
4. Animals must be removed immediately after the show. No shelter will be provided.
5. Additional premium money of \$350 to be allotted for youth (4-H/FFA) in the county, to be awarded on the Danish System on female classes. Youth's animals must be registered and entered in member's name and exhibited by youth to be eligible for premiums. Maximum pay will be \$10 per animal. One premium per animal, three premiums per member. Youth's animals must be designated at time of entry.
6. In the event only one entry is made in any ring, the judges at their discretion will award a prize of such grade as the entry deserves and prize money will be awarded accordingly.

SPECIAL DAIRY PRODUCTION CLASSES RULES

1. Open to any dairyman on official test.
2. All breeds will be shown separately.
3. The following age classifications will be shown: Cows 3 years of age, Cows 4 years of age, Aged Cow
4. Only official DHIR, DHIA, and HIR records will be accepted.
5. The exhibitor must present the official herd record book or an official copy of production records of record to each entry to the show official when entering his animals.
6. Only the animal's most recent completed actual milk record of 305 days or less may be used.
7. In case of a break in production, or if the cow has failed to freshen, records completed 18 months prior to the fair date will not be accepted.
8. The following premiums will be paid in each class:

3-year-old -	1st-\$20, 2nd-\$15, 3rd-\$10, 4th-\$5
4-year-old -	1st-\$20, 2nd-\$15, 3rd-\$10, 4th-\$5
Aged Cow -	1st-\$20, 2nd-\$15, 3rd-\$10, 4th-\$5
