## Demo Derby Rules

- A. Each driver must fill out an entry form, sign release, and show proof of age at registration table. Only one entry per driver.
- B. Each driver must be at least 21, or have notarized release signed by parent or guardian, and a valid driver's license.
- C. Owners of cars that are not driving must also sign a release form at the registration table.
- D. The Southern Kentucky Fair Reserves the right to approve or reject any and all entries.
- E. The Southern Kentucky Fair Board, Inc will not be held responsible for any cars, parts, or personal property before, during, or after the event.
- F. All cars are to be removed from the fairgrounds by midnight or they become the property of the SOKY Fair Board, Inc.
- G. No protests after cars are inspected, all inspected cars run.
- H. All complaints will be heard at the announcer's table following each heat, 5 minutes will be allowed to file. Head judge's decision will be final.
- I. Any owner, driver, crew, or their family using abusive language in arena, registration, or announcer's tables, in pit, or crowd area that driver will be disqualified and forfeit all prize, registration, and admission money.
- J. No drinking of alcoholic beverages or use of controlled substances will be tolerated on the track, in the pit area etc., Any driver, owner, crew, or their family caught under the influence will be disqualified and forfeit all prize, registration, and admission money.
- K. During the "heats" NO ONE is allowed in the track area at the end of the heat, 1 crew member only can enter the track area to help remove car. Anyone not adhering to this can be disqualified.
- L. The owner/driver is responsible for their actions and those of their crew and families.
- M. Drive SAFELY and SLOWLY to and from the track and pit areas- we do not want anyone to get hurt! Especially spectators.
- N. Drivers' meeting will be held at the registration building.
- O. No profanity will be allowed on any portion of the car.

## Type of Car

Any 1980 or newer car or station wagon

### PREPARATION OF CAR (TO BE DONE BEFORE ARRIVAL AT FAIRGROUNDS)

1. All glass, including windshield, side and rear windows, and all lights are to be removed.
2. Molding strips, all glass, bottom portion of back seat and all plastic parts must be removed from the car before reaching fairgrounds.
3. Any sharp fins must be removed or mashed down.
4. Cars must be clean inside- no trash or car parts in car.
5. Original gas tank must be removed.
6. Rear End swaps are allowed. No truck rear-ends allowed or coil to leak changes.
7. Fasten hood down in up to 6 locations. Sheet metal to sheet metal only. Hood must be open for inspection.
8. Trunk lids and doors can be welded shut 2- inch wide steel bat at seams.
9. Trunk lid must have a 20"x20" hole to inspect inside the trunk or must open.
10. No frame or body seam welding that includes inside of doors.
11. No adding steel to the frames allowed.
12. Front two (2) body bushing may be removed. They can be replaced with 1-inch or smaller all thread and 3- inch washer. This may run through the hood. All other body bushings must remain in place.
13. Special bumpers, bumper reinforcement, fabrications or trailer hitches are not allowed.
14. Bumper changes are allowed, but must be a car bumper.
15. Bumper shocks are allowed to be welded. The bumper brackets can be welded to the frame.
16. Motor swaps allowed.
17. Engine mounts can be welded or chained down.
18. Holes may be cut through the fire wall to access the engine or the distributor.
19. Distributor must remain in engine compartment. Distributor guards are not allowed.
20. Slip drive shafts are not allowed.
21. Radiator must remain in original position. Wire can be used if radiator mounts are missing.
22. Transmission coolers are allowed and must be in the engine compartment. May be in driver compartment if they are in a sealed container securely fastened.
23. No guards or wire in front of radiator.
24. 4-Point cage is allowed but cannot be fastened to the frame. Roll bars are allowed, but must go below 4-point cage.
25. Driver and front passenger doors may be reinforced with steel bar, angle, or pipe. Length may extend only 6 inches past the door in any direction must be securely fastened. Mesh or screen is recommended in driver's door window and windshield on front of driver. On steel bar is required in the windshield area extending from the fire wall area to the top of the car.
26. A steel support is allowed directly behind the front seat and at the dash. This may extend from one side of the car to the other. Must be securely fastened.
27. Battery must be securely fastened.
28. Fenders can be cut out of clearance but cannot be rewelded.
29. The gas tank must be securely fastened and covered in the rear seat area. **Plastic boat tanks are not allowed unless they are protected by Steel so they cannot be crushed.** Any sign of leaking fuel will cause for elimination. No gas tank protectors allowed, ( any extra bars in backseat area)
30. Any size tires are allowed. Car must be level and D.O.T. tires.
31. Suspension may be altered, but may not be changed. 20-inches maximum height. Car must be level.
32. Pre-ran cars are allowed. No pre-bending car must be to rules.
33. Car must have brakes at all times.
34. Each car must be signed in at least ½ hour before race time. Cars will then be inspected and numbered.
35. All cars must be inspected and flagged before entering arena.

### Running

36. Neck brace and fire suit are highly recommended.
37. Fire extinguisher is recommended within reach of driver.
38. Drivers must remain in the car until heat is over or until there is a break in action and a track official is notified that you are getting out.
39. Safety belts, secured to frame, full face helmet or helmet with goggles are required for all entries.
40. If driver's door comes open during event, the car will be disqualified.
41. Any type of fire in the car will automatically disqualify the car.
42. There will be no deliberate head "Head On" collisions and no deliberate hitting in the driver's door. Anyone doing so will be disqualified immediately.
43. Cars must have dependable and sufficient brakes at all times and boundaries, must be observed. In the event of a rollover, a car leaving boundaries, or 3 or more wheels leaving the boundaries the car will be disqualified.
44. Contact must be made, with an active car every 60 seconds. Playing "possum" will be grounds for disqualification after being warned. This decision will be made by the head judge. You will be warned once.
45. Every effort will be made, to keep cars from "teaming together." Once the event is down to 4 or less cars you must hit all remaining cars equally- in number of hits and degree of impact. No DOUBLE TEAMING- judge will warn once, then two suspected of double teaming will go until one of them is put out, while the other car sits idle.
46. If the car is on the log barrier, no one is allowed to hit them.
47. Any car/driver disqualified forfeits all registration, prizes, and admission money.
48. Last car(s) running to make contact will be declared the winner(s).
49. All heat winners and feature winners cars are subject to re inspection by judges. Anyone who has altered their car will be disqualified.
50. Car qualifies for feature, driver substitutions can be made if necessary for injury or sickness, upon notice to and approval by head judge.
51. Everyone must pay gate admission.
52. Cars must enter through Glen Lily Road gate.

Inspections of cars will be done by 3 drivers selected at random and 2 fair committee members. Any car you feel is illegal needs to be told to inspectors before derby starts the inspector and the person questioning the car will re-inspect the car together.

The derby will be composed of individual heats, one consolation heat (no prize money, and one feature prize money will go to winners, two (2) of each heat and 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> places in the feature. Feature will be comprised of 2 winners from each heat run. Decisions of the official judges will be final as to heat winners. The head judge's decision will be final on all matters.
